Covid-19 Policies & Procedures

Effective May 4th, 2020

ALL VISITORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO COMPLETE THE ONLINE SCREENING ASSEMENT BELOW BEFORE VISITING THE GOLF COURSE AND CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES:

Upon arrival at the St. Boniface Golf Club, you will be directed through our pulmonary check point. An attendant will then ask a series of screening questions and confirm your scheduled tee-time. Members and Guests are asked not to arrive more than **20 MINUTES** prior to their scheduled tee-times.

Clubhouse, Proshop and practice facility access will be directed by the check point attendant at the appropriate time. No more than 8 people will be permitted in the Clubhouse at one time. Physical distancing indicators are posted throughout the Clubhouse for your safety and others.

Bag drop is available at Check Point 1 for your convenience. Attendants will be wearing disposable gloves when handling your belongings. Bags will be placed on a sanitized pull cart or power cart for your retrieval.

CLUBHOUSE ACCESS:

Limited access to the Clubhouse and internal facilities will be granted at this time. The Fitness Room, Locker Rooms and second Floor facilities; including the restaurant, will remain closed until further notice. The Proshop may be accessed through Check Point 1, as well as Administrative services.

A single stall washroom is available off the main floor foyer for pre-post round requirements. All washrooms are being cleaned and sanitized on an increased frequency.

Please be aware of all physical distancing indicators when visiting the clubhouse; 6ft/2 meters distancing between patrons is required.

Hand sanitizer is available at all entrances and exits and usage is encouraged.

ON-COURSE:

As per Provincial Government and Public Health Authorities orders, groups of no more than 4 will be permitted at this time. The use of power carts will be restricted to single rider only; unless individuals are from the same household.

To ensure a contactless game; all tee markers, ball washers, bunker rakes and water jugs have been removed from the golf course.

Flags are not to be removed or touched at any time. A raised disc has been installed in each hole to prevent your ball from dropping in the hole.

Indicators have been painted on the tee boxes to identify the front, middle and back tees.

On-course toilets are available at their original locations, with increased cleaning and sanitization.

Players are expected to adhere to physical distancing requirements at all times, this includes refrainment of the traditional post round handshake.

Course ambassadors will be monitoring the golf course on an increased basis to ensure all new implementations are being adhered to. Individuals who fail to respect the safety of others, or do not follow the policies and procedures outlined will be subject to removal off the course or possible suspension of golfing privileges.
